- A. Titanic _____ 1. Robert Fulton's steamboat, its route ran from New York to Albany on the Hudson River.
- B. Lusitania _____ 2. Famous British luxury passenger ocean liner; it was used as a troop transport in WWII.
- C. Queen Mary _____ 3. Ocean liner which struck an iceberg and sank in 1912.
- D. Santa Maria _____ 4. It landed at Plymouth Rock in 1620 with lots of Pilgrims aboard.
- E. HMS Beagle _____ 5. Anthropologist Thor Heyerdahl's raft, which he paddled across the Pacific in support of his scientific theories.
- F. Bismarck _____ 6. German WWII battleship which sank the British ship HMS *Hood* in 1941.
- G. HMS Bounty _____ 7. This Navy ship sank as a result of an explosion in Havana, Cuba, in 1898; this event precipitated the Spanish-American War.
- H. Clermont _____ 8. English ship whose crew mutinied in 1789 against its captain, William Bligh.
- I. USS Constitution _____ 9. British ship on which scientist Charles Darwin traveled in the 1830s; this journey led to Darwin's formulating his theory of evolution.
- J. Kon Tiki _____ 10. Christopher Columbus's flagship.
- K. USS Maine _____ 11. American frigate known as "Old Ironsides"; it is the oldest commissioned ship afloat in the world.
- L. Mayflower _____ 12. British luxury ocean liner torpedoed by a German submarine in 1915, killing 1,198 people.
