

# WATER ART

## Bubble Painting Art

Need: Bubble blowing liquid      Straw  
Water based paint                  Small cup  
White paper (or scrap paper)

Ask a parent where you may be messy with paint.  
Dress for mess.

Fill the small cup about  $\frac{1}{4}$  of the way with bubble liquid.

Add a couple drops of paint. Mix it gently with the straw.

Hold the cup of bubble paint over the white paper.

Blow through the straw to make bubbles. They will spill over the top of your cup making a wonderful painting as they pop onto the paper. ooOOooOOoo!

After the bubbles pop, let the painting dry.

Experiment. Your results will vary.



## Disappearing Painting

Need: Water

Brush, Q-tip or sponge  
Outdoor sidewalk or wood  
Scrap or butcher paper

Ask a parent where you may play with water.  
If you use colored paper: C-A-U-T-I-O-N --  
Color in the wet paper may stain what it touches.

"Paint" pictures using WATER on a sidewalk,  
a paved driveway, outdoor wood or a piece of  
butcher paper.

The wet places will look darker than the dry places.

Watch your water picture vanish. The liquid turns into  
vapor and it floats off into the air.

Then you can make another painting.
